

MOTIONS to amend the BY-LAWS of the

CANADIAN UNITARIAN UNIVERSALIST WOMEN'S ASSOCIATION

1. **WHEREAS** the Council of the Association has determined that there is widespread consensus to alter the name of the Association to Canadian Unitarian Universalist Women's Association,

Now therefore I move that the title of the Association be amended to Canadian Unitarian Universalist Women's Association wherever it appears in the By-laws.

2. **WHEREAS** by Section 10 of the By-laws [Execution of Documents], the Treasurer of the Association has sole signing authority for the administration of the operating bank account if the **balance** does not exceed \$1500, this does not reflect the original intent, which was that the Treasurer have such authority if an individual **withdrawal or cheque** does not exceed \$1500,

Now therefore I move that Section 10 be amended by deleting the words "the balance" in the second sentence and replacing them with the words "a proposed expenditure".

SECTION 10 - GENERAL

EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS

All of the members of the National Council shall have signing authority, and any two of them may sign contracts, documents or any instruments in writing. However, the Treasurer will have sole signing authority for the administration of the operating bank account if a proposed expenditure does not exceed \$1500 dollars. Where this is exceeded, two signatures are required.]
